

DUFOUR 32

The Dufour 32 was not only created with sporty, intuitive sailing in mind, but with a willingness to experimenting with an eye toward making a real difference in terms of life afloat. The result is an allnew design that creates a tremendous amount of volume in a small LOA while including a host of innovative features. A set of solar panels, for example, has been built into the mainsail cover, while the transom drops down and converts into an inflatable, removable swim platform. The boat's fold up tiller can also be swung completely out of the way to maximize cockpit space while on the hook Performance and standard versions are available, with the mainsheet running to either the cockpit sole or the coachroof if you choose the latter. Belowdecks, owners can choose from three aesthetic schemes titled Europe, Boston and Millenium. The lack of backstay makes it possible to equip the boat with a performance, square-top main for some additional get-up-and go.
